All About Destinations, as well as the school, needs a letter for each student stating dates and place(s) of travel, contact phone numbers, and authorization for the school chaperone to take the student on the trip. The following situations determine who signs the document:

1. If married, both parents sign;
2. If legal guardians, both sign;
3. If divorced, both sign, or if one parent has sole custody, a signature of the person with sole custody;
4. If deceased, the surviving parent signs, and if possible, bring a copy of the death certificate.

The signature of both parents/guardians is the most advisable.
